



NCTVET Online Assessment 2015-16: Flexible and Responsive; Making Lives Easier..



There has been a rapid growth of technology in the education sector over the last two decades. It is therefore no surprise, that the NCTVET has seen the need to embrace the use of the online platform as a tool for providing efficient and effective assessment services.

For the past two years, the NCTVET has partnered with TVET Development, Support Systems (TDSS) and Information Systems and Technical Support (ISTS) in adopting the Moodle software to facilitate online the assessment modality.

Assessment September 2015 & February 2016

For the financial year 2015-16, the NCTVET will continue to utilise the online modality during the September 2015 and February 2016 assessment cycles.

This modality will be used for the administration of only the external written component of the assessments. During these cycles, the following skill areas will be offered via this modality:

INSTITUTIONAL INFRASTRUCTURE REQUIREMENTS

Participating institutions/clients are required to ensure that the following Information Technology (IT) resources are in place:

- Computer Lab with a minimum of 15 -20 computers;
- Reliable internet bandwidth (recommended 5 - 6 MB per location);
- One computer per candidate, with a minimum of 8 MB RAM and Firefox browser installed (as Moodle works best with Firefox);
- Installation of Flash plug-in for each computer.



In order to ensure a smooth transition from paper-based to online assessment, a practice site has been established for you to navigate and practise using the Moodle Platform. Navigation instructions will be provided in upcoming issue via this medium.
